Pursuant to our Stipulation in the above referenced dockets, Connect Holding LLC and Brightspeed of Pennsylvania, LLC are submitting our Annual Certification filing in accordance with the commitments in the terms and conditions made in the settlement agreement. As of December 31, 2023, we passed a total number of 47,026 premises. We are experiencing system problems this afternoon and are not able to provide a breakdown of the total by RES and BUS. We will submit that data under separate cover as soon the problem is resolved.

We exceeded our total number of premises passed commitment in 2023 and are on track to complete this year's required premise passings by the end of 2024. No state broadband grants were pursued or awarded to support these builds.
