## 2<sup>nd</sup> REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE JEFFREY A. WATSON:

As the Complainants in the above-mentioned mentioned case, we are requesting an extension of time of the briefing schedule.

Larry R. and Ellen M. Kramer (“the Complainants”) hereby file this Request for Extension of Time of the Briefing Schedule in this case against Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed” or the “Company”) pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations at 52 Pa. Code §5. 61 and §5.103(c).

### I. BACKGROUND

- A. The formal complaint in the instant case was filed in October, 2017.
- B. In September of 2018, Mrs. Kramer went legally blind in her right eye. That eye has been totally blind since January of 2021.
- C. In late 2019, Mrs. Kramer began having intermittent struggles with her left eye.
- D. The hearing in the instant case was in June of 2020. Mrs. Kramer explained these visual challenges prior to and during the hearing.
- E. In October of 2020, Mrs. Kramer’s left eye went legally blind for three months with only difficult sight some days, weeks or months.
- F. This case was put on a stay in November of 2020 just days before the brief was due. The brief was unable to be completed due to the extreme vision issues and many other things that the Complainants normally do had to be curtailed or delayed ever since October 2020.
- G. On the day that the Respondent submitted a response to the Complainants request for extension of time, Mrs. Kramer began writing a response working on it until 2:00 AM. However, ever since then, Mrs. Kramer has been unable to do anything on the computer until now and that has been with tears and challenges and with font so large that only 4 lines of type can be on the computer monitor at a time.

THEREFORE, Complainants are requesting an extension of time of 180 days in order to have any time to complete the brief. Should no extension be granted,

Complainants will be denied due process under the circumstances. An extension of time of 180 days from now to submit the brief is respectfully requested.


