Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 6, 2024 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company on behalf of its Met-Ed Rate District<sup>1</sup> (“the Company”).

Ms. Platt (“Complainant”) has previously indicated that her filing titled “Main Brief” dated March 30, 2020, should be considered as her direct testimony. Therefore, the Company anticipates that the Complainant will not be submitting expert testimony in this matter, only factual testimony. As a result, the Company expects that it will only need to submit rebuttal testimony of one witness, Mr. David Villao, to rebut any factual testimony submitted by the Complainant.

The Company suggests the following schedule for testimony submission:

Submitted on March 30, 2020	Complainant’s written direct testimony
March 15, 2024	Complainant’s written supplemental direct testimony
April 19, 2024	The Company’s rebuttal testimony
May 17, 2024	Complainant written surrebuttal testimony

The Company reserves its right to provide additional witness testimony if the Complainant submits supplemental testimony from any new witness.

<sup>1</sup> On January 1, 2024, FirstEnergy Corp.'s Pennsylvania operating companies (i.e., Metropolitan Edison Company, Pennsylvania Electric Company, Pennsylvania Power Company, and West Penn Power Company) merged into FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company. Due to the merger transaction, the affected operating companies' tariffs were consolidated into a single tariff, with each former operating company's rates becoming its own rate district. As such, the customers of the former Metropolitan Edison Company have their own separate and distinct rate district under FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company’s tariff.
