DeVoe on January 5, 2024 (“Order”), FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, on behalf its Met-Ed Rate District (the “Company”) submits this letter as a status report in the above-referenced matter. As directed by the Order, the Company has timely filed a Motion for Summary Judgement on January 24, 2024.
