Your application for the right to provide common carrier service, transporting persons in group and party service, using vehicles having a seating capacity of no more than 28 passengers, including the driver, has been reviewed.

It has been determined that the following requirements must be met before service may be provided within Pennsylvania. **You may not operate until these requirements are satisfied.**

**YOU ARE ADVISED: THAT YOU MUST FILE A FORM E, AS EVIDENCE OF BODILY INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE LIABILITY INSURANCE. Your insurance company must file this form with the exact name of the applicant as it appears on this Letter - PTG BUS, LLC. The State MC A-6426821 must be listed to identify your account. **FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.**

You may want to operate prior to filing permanent proof of insurance. Temporary proof of insurance consists of one of the following:

- a. A copy of the declaration page of the insurance policy; **or**
- b. A copy of a valid binder of insurance.


Upon the filing of insurance, and upon compliance with any other provision of this letter, a certificate of public convenience will be issued authorizing the service cited above.

*To transport, as a motor common carrier, persons in group and party service, operating vehicles with a seating capacity of more than 15 passengers, including the driver, between points in Pennsylvania, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.*

If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered.

**Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in dismissal of your application, and require the filing of a new application and filing fee.**
