COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby represents as follows:

1. That DUTCH EXPRESS LLC, Respondent, maintains a mailing address of 615 Korisa Drive, Huntingdon Valley, PA 19006.

2. On March 3, 2023, by Commission Secretarial letter, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission authorizing transportation, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, property, excluding household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania at PUC utility code no. 8925996 at A-2023-3038530.

3. On December 19, 2023, PUC Enforcement Officer Michael Johncola spoke with Dutch Express LLC owner, Marcus Hood, who relayed that he was no longer operating. Officer Johncola then advised the carrier of the process to cancel the authority for his company. As of February 1, 2024 has not completed the cancellation request. Officer Johncola attempted to contact by phoning, emailing and a certified letter. Respondent but has failed to cancel authority for Dutch Express LLC.

4. That Respondent, by failing to achieve a satisfactory evaluation on a safety fitness review, violated 66 Pa §501(c) & §504. The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent with this Commission at utility code 8925996.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued to Dutch Express LLC at PUC utility code number 8925996.

- C. If you file an Answer, which admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty.
- D. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will be assigned to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The judge is not bound by the optional fine set forth above.
