**BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT
MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE JOHN M. COOGAN:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby submits this Motion for Continuance of Hearing to continue the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. On January 17, 2024, a Telephonic Pre-Hearing Conference was held in this matter.
2. A Telephonic Evidentiary Hearing in this matter is set for Wednesday, February 28, 2024.
3. On January 22, 2024, the Municipal Authority of Hazle Township (“MAHT”) served interrogatories and a request for production of documents pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.341 and 5.349 on I&E.
4. On February 9, 2024, I&E provided its response to the interrogatories and request for production of documents to MAHT.
5. On February 21, 2024, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.341, I&E served upon MAHT

its own set of interrogatories (“I&E Interrogatories”).

6. The date for MAHT to provide a response to I&E Interrogatories is March 12, 2024. 52 Pa. Code § 5.342(d).

7. On February 21, 2024, I&E contacted counsel for MAHT via e-mail to inquire whether they would consent to a continuance of the hearing in this matter.

8. Counsel for MAHT responded on February 21, 2024, that they would not object to a motion by I&E to continue the hearing.

9. Also on February 21, 2024, I&E and MAHT began discussing the potential for settlement of the case via e-mail.

10. Counsel for MAHT and I&E have set a time on February 23, 2024, to further discuss a potential settlement in this matter.

WHEREFORE, to afford MAHT time to serve responses to the I&E Interrogatories and to provide the Parties adequate time to negotiate a settlement, I&E respectfully requests that the Telephonic Evidentiary Hearing be continued for 30 days.
