To Whom It May Concern:

On January 23, 2024, the Commission received Lapp Transport LLC's request to abandon its certificate of public convenience (CPC). After reviewing the request, the Commission, by Secretarial Letter dated January 25, 2024, advised you that Lapp Transport LLC's CPC would be cancelled within 20 days of January 25, 2024.

The Secretarial Letter further advised that Lapp Transport LLC owes the Commission \$106 for unpaid assessments from 2022 and 2023 and that if Lapp Transport LLC did not pay that amount within 20 days, the Commission would refer the matter (1) to the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General for appropriate action and (2) to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to have the registration of Lapp Transport LLC's vehicles suspended. It has also been discovered that the applicant was sent a Secretarial Letter dated July 22, 2019, imposing a penalty of \$500 for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with the Commission at Docket No. C-2019-3008908.


Lapp Transport LLC's CPC issued at A-8920498 — and all rights, powers, and privileges granted thereby—is hereby cancelled effective February 28, 2024. The Commission has also *dismissed* the proceedings at C-2019-3008908, M-2023-3041465, and M-2024-3045178

Further, the 20-day deadline for payment has passed and Lapp Transport LLC still has not paid the outstanding assessment and fine. As such, the Commission will refer the matter to the Office of Attorney General and the Department of Transportation.
