COMES NOW, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, by its attorney, Anthony A. Czuchnicki, Assistant Counsel, and in its Petition to Transfer Jurisdiction to the Court of Common Pleas of York County respectfully represents:

1. The name and address of your Petitioner is the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, P.O. Box 8212, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17105-8212.
2. The name and address of counsel for the Petitioner is Anthony A. Czuchnicki, Assistant Counsel, Office of Chief Counsel, Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, P.O. Box 8212, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17105-8212.
3. By Order adopted and entered December 7, 2023, in the proceeding docketed at Application Docket No. A-2022-3035024, your Honorable Commission approved the Application of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to alter the public crossing (DOT 872 491 H) by replacement of the existing bridge where State Route 0083 (Interstate 83) crosses, above grade, the tracks of CSX Transportation, Inc. and Codorus Creek, located in Spring Garden Township and North York Borough, York County, and the allocation of costs incident thereto. (Exhibit “A”)

4. By the aforesaid Order, your Honorable Commission directed, at paragraphs 2 and 3, that certain property be appropriated for the purpose of the aforesaid project, pursuant to Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code. 66 Pa.C.S. §2702.

5. The aforesaid project necessitated the appropriation of property within Spring Garden Township and North York Borough, York County, filed with the Recorder of Deeds of York County on October 4, 2023, by Instrument No. 2023038457. (Department Claim No. 6601292000).

6. The Department has determined that the just compensation for the property appropriation is \$9,500.00 which, as of the date of this Petition, has not been accepted by the Railway.

8. A true and correct copy of this claim for property damage pursuant to Section 2704 of the Public Utility Code was duly served upon the Railway. 66 Pa.C.S. §2704.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation requests your Honorable Commission, pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. Section 2704, refer this matter to the Court of Common Pleas of York County, for the filing of a Petition to deposit the estimated just compensation amount into court pursuant to the Eminent Domain Code, 26 Pa.C.S. § 307.

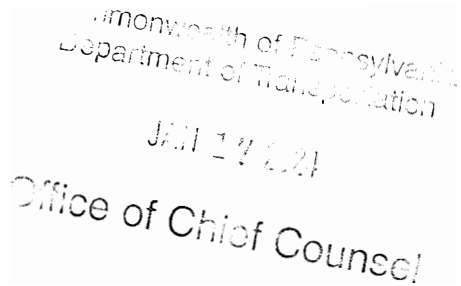

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 7, 2022, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (Department) filed an application with the Commission for approval to alter the public grade separated crossing (DOT 872 491 H) by replacement of the existing highway bridge. On November 29, 2022, a virtual field investigation and conference was held. At the virtual field conference, the Department averred it would be necessary for the Commission to appropriate certain portions of railroad property to accommodate the proposed bridge replacement.

Paragraph No. 5 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated February 16, 2023, directed the Department to submit for approval the right-of-way plans for the highway-railroad crossing alteration project involved in this proceeding.

The final right-of-way plans were received September 28, 2023, and consist of twelve (12) sheets. The Department is requesting the Commission approve the right-of-way plans that include appropriation of four (4) tracts of property from CSX Transportation, Inc.

The Department avers that each party to the proceeding was served a copy of the plan for review. None of the parties have advised the Commission that it objects to approval of the plan.

The metes and bounds descriptions required for the property appropriation associated with the said right-of-way plans were submitted to the Commission on September 28, 2023, and are defined herein by this Order.

We hereby approve the right-of-way plans and appropriate the property described in detail in the ordering paragraphs.

The parties are reminded that any failure to comply with any Secretarial Letter or Order in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §3301.

The record having been certified to this Commission, we issue this Order pursuant to Sections 335(a) and 2702 of the Public Utility Code, (66 Pa. C.S. §335(a), §2702);

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the right-of-way plans submitted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation on September 28, 2023, consisting of twelve (12) sheets and identified as “COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DRAWINGS RE-ESTABLISHING LIMITED ACCESS HIGHWAY AND AUTHORIZING ACQUISITION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR STATE ROUTE 0083 SECTION 091 R/W IN YORK COUNTY,” are hereby approved and made part hereof.

2. That in accordance with the provisions of Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §2702, the following described properties be and are hereby taken and appropriated for the purpose of the improvement in accordance with the right-of-way plans approved in Paragraph No. 1 of this Order, and that Paragraph No. 2 of this Order shall be recorded in the Recorder of Deeds of York County, and shall be indexed under the name or names of the record owners of said property, grantor(s), and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, grantee, at the sole cost and expense of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, applicant herein; the above said plans having been recorded by York County on October 4, 2023 by Instrument Number 2023038457 to which recording reference is made in and of the description of those tracts of land more particularly described in detail below:
