The Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 507, provides that a public utility municipal contract shall be deemed valid thirty days after it is filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) unless the Commission extends the review period. In order to adequately review the above-captioned agreement, it is necessary that the consideration period be extended. Therefore, you are hereby notified that the period for the consideration of the above-referenced agreement is extended until further order of the Commission.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition to appeal this action of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this Secretarial Letter.
