To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, from points in Douglass Township, Berks County, and within an airline distance of 60 statutory miles of the boundaries of the municipality, to points in Pennsylvania, and return;

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADVANCE NOTICE

Advanced reservations must be made at least one hour prior to when service is to be rendered.

NON-EXCLUSIVITY OF SERVICE

Service is provided on a non-exclusive basis.

RATES

All rates are specifically stated for paratransit service, mileage and waiting time.

OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES

Any and all additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of either the passenger or the party making the reservation (such as, but not limited to, tolls, parking fees, entrance fees, and other out of pocket expenses) shall be added to the charge for the trip.

MILEAGE RATE

Mileage hereunder shall be governed by the actual odometer reading of the vehicle or vehicles employed from point of pickup to point of drop off rounded to the nearest mile. Traditional rounding methods shall be utilized, except for transports of 0.1 to 0.4 miles, as the minimum mileage charge shall be 1.0 miles.

CONTRACT SERVICES

Contract services provided will be for a term of not less than 30 days for prequalified persons under federal, state, county or municipal governmental agency contracts. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contract, copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

HOLIDAY SURCHARGE

A holiday surcharge will apply in addition to the base rate, for all trips which occur on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

SCHEDULE OF RATES

1. **BASE RATES:** For all loaded-mile trips from the point of pickup to the point of destination.

\$ \$100.00 per passenger per trip (i.e., one way)

2. **MILEAGE:** A mileage charge set forth below, applies in addition to the base rate listed above, for all loaded miles from the point of pickup to the point of destination.

\$ \$6.00 per mile or fraction thereof

3. **WAITING TIME:** A waiting time charge set forth below applies, in addition to the base rate listed above whenever a wait is involved for any reason.

\$ \$100.00 per hour or fraction thereof

4. **HOLIDAY SURCHARGE:** A holiday surcharge set forth below will apply in addition to the base rate, for all trips which occur on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
