ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 16, 2024, Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. - Wastewater Division (Veolia-WD), Utility Code 230077, filed Supplement No. 5 to Tariff Wastewater – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 (Supplement No. 5) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to become effective April 16, 2024. Supplement No. 5 would increase Veolia-WD's total annual operating revenues for wastewater service by approximately \$568,719, or 34.8%.

On February 16, 2024, the Office of Consumer Advocate filed a formal complaint at Docket No. C-2024-3046521. On February 26, 2024, the Office of Small Business Advocate filed a formal complaint at Docket No. C-2024-3046956. Pursuant to Section 1308(d) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1308(d) (relating to general rate increases), the filing will be suspended by operation of law until

November 16, 2024, unless permitted by Commission Order to become effective at an earlier date.

Investigation and analysis of this proposed tariff supplement and the supporting data indicates that the proposed changes in rates, rules, and regulations may be unlawful, unjust, unreasonable, and contrary to public interest. It also appears that consideration should be given to the reasonableness of Veolia-WD's existing rates, rules, and regulations; **THEREFORE**,

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That an investigation on Commission motion be, and hereby is, instituted to determine the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the rates, rules, and regulations contained in Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. Wastewater Division's proposed Supplement No. 5 to Tariff Wastewater Pa. P.U.C. No. 2.
- 2. That Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. Wastewater Division's proposed Supplement No. 5 to Tariff Wastewater Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 is suspended by operation of law until November 16, 2024, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission.
- 3. That within ten (10) days following the entry date of this Order, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 53.71, Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. Wastewater Division shall e-file (or file) a tariff supplement, which shall bear no effective date, with the Commission and post the tariff supplement at the offices of Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. Wastewater Division announcing that the aforementioned tariff supplement is suspended until November 16, 2024. A sample copy of a suspension supplement is provided in Attachment A of this Order.
- 4. That the investigation instituted in Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of this Order shall include consideration of the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the existing rates, rules, and regulations of Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. Wastewater Division.

5. That this case be assigned to the Office of Administrative Law Judge for Alternative Dispute Resolution, if possible, and for the prompt scheduling of such hearings as may be necessary culminating in the issuance of a recommended decision.

6. That a copy of this Order shall be served upon Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. - Wastewater Division, the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and any persons who have filed formal complaints against the proposed tariff supplement.
