Dear Judge Collins:

On December 8, 2023, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or “Company”) filed a Motion to Stay the above-referenced proceeding in light of Scott Township’s pending Emergency Demolition Order for the service address of Antonio Geatti (“Complainant”). The Motion to Stay remains pending before Your Honor and the evidentiary hearing for this matter is currently scheduled for Tuesday, March 26, 2024, at 10:00 AM.

As an update for Your Honor, it is PPL Electric’s understanding that Scott Township has yet to take final action on the Emergency Demolition Order, which remains in force for the Complainant’s service address. As such, it appears that the scheduled hearing could take place before the Township takes final action regarding the Emergency Demolition Order.

PPL Electric has requested a stay because the disposition of the Emergency Demolition Order will directly affect the outcome of this proceeding, in which the Complainant’s requested relief is the restoration of electric service to the service address. Whether electric service can be safely restored is directly dependent upon the final disposition of Scott Township’s Emergency Demolition Order, which will be lifted only if and after the Complainant makes certain changes to his service address to render it safe for habitation. If the necessary changes are not made to the service address, then the imminent demolition of the service address would render the instant proceeding moot.

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For these reasons, PPL Electric continues to believe that it would be prudent to stay this matter until the Emergency Demolition Order in place for the Complainant's service address has been lifted by Scott Township.


