
TUS Provide the current status of the Montour-Milton-Sunbury 230 kV transmission project and a breakdown of the project costs to date.

PPL Response PPL Electric has completed the construction and restoration of the Sunbury-Milton and Milton-Montour 230 kV transmission lines. All right-of way has been restored and all environmental permits have been closed. PPL Electric has spent a total of \$69,160,000 to complete the project as described within the Letter of Notification.
