Dear Judge Johnson:

This office represents Petitioner, City of Lancaster – Water Bureau (“City”) in the above-referenced proceeding. As you know, the City, along with the Pennsylvania Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”), and the Pennsylvania Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) (collectively, the “Parties”) have been engaged in settlement discussions concerning this matter. The Parties thank Your Honor for the additional time needed to complete those discussions.

I am pleased to report that the City and the OCA have reached a settlement in principle, to which I&E does not object. The OSBA has not yet expressed an opinion as to whether it will join or not object to the settlement, which resolves all issues raised by the parties in this matter.

The City, along with the OCA and I&E, will now work to prepare the Joint Petition for Complete Settlement and accompanying documents for Your Honor’s review, and will file those documents as soon as possible.
