The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's Retail Market Enhancement Surcharge (RMES) filing submitted on March 31, 2024 to become effective June 1, 2024. In the filing, the company is not proposing to revise its current effective RMES rate of 0.00%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed RMES rate for the twelve-month period of June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2025 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to remain effective as filed.

The RMES charge is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
