Request for Information

- 1.) Just to clarify, is it your intention to only provide household goods in use service between points in the Counties of Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lancaster, Montgomery, and the City and County of Philadelphia? Do you plan to transport household goods in use from these counties to other points in Pennsylvania?

- 2.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. Please review Title 52 Pa Code §31.134 – Criminal History to see what is required of motor carriers.
 - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks.
 - i. How often will the criminal background checks be conducted?
 - ii. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed?

- 3.) For Question #7 of the Verified Statement of Applicant you are to describe your vehicle safety maintenance plan. You mention that your vehicles will undergo annual inspections, as well as pre/post trip inspections, but failed to identify a satisfactory periodic vehicle maintenance plan.
 - a. What type of periodic vehicle maintenance plan will you have for your vehicles, in addition to yearly inspection and pre/post trip inspections.

- 4.) Please resubmit a **DATED** Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet).

1. Yes, the plan will be transporting household goods in use between the counties of Berks, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Lancaster, Montgomery and the city of and county of Philadelphia.
2. Criminal background checks will be conducted upon hiring, and then every 5 years for each employee. We will be mitigating this responsibility to Foley services which will also maintain these records. Additionally, I will maintain these reports electronically on my personally protected computer as well as a paper file stored in a lockable filing cabinet.
3. In addition to an annual inspection and pre and post trip driver inspections, we will also implement bi-annual inspections of all trucks. Additionally, DVIR's or Driver Vehicle Inspection Reports will be filled out daily to identify any problems or potential issues that may become a problem so that they can be addressed and fixed in a prompt manner. These will be recorded and maintained for each truck we own in a file for maintenance and routine inspection reports.

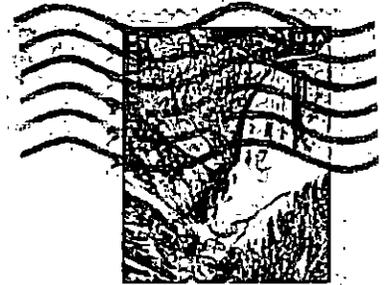
