BY THE COMMISSION:


Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for consideration and disposition is Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.'s Petition for Reconsideration filed on April 19, 2024. The Petition for Reconsideration seeks reconsideration of certain portions of the Commission's Order of April 4, 2024, at the above-captioned docket.

Pursuant to Rule 1701 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, Pa.R.A.P. § 1701 (relating to effect of appeal generally), the Commission must act to grant a petition for reconsideration within thirty (30) days of the date of entry of the order for which reconsideration is sought or otherwise lose jurisdiction to do so if a petition for

review is timely filed.¹ The thirty-day (30) period within which the Commission must act on the Petition for Reconsideration in order to preserve jurisdiction relative to the April 4, 2024 Order ends on May 6, 2024. Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. timely filed the Petition for Reconsideration on April 19, 2024. Accordingly, we shall grant reconsideration pending a review on the merits; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED: That the Petition for Reconsideration, filed by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. on April 19, 2024, is hereby granted, pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.'s Petition for Reconsideration.
