Petition of Williams Companies, Inc. for Declaratory Order

OPINION AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Before the Commission for consideration and disposition is the Petition for Reconsideration (Petition), filed by Williams Companies, Inc. (Williams), on April 19, 2024, seeking reconsideration of the Opinion and Order entered April 4, 2024 which declared that the solar PV project proposed in the Petition was eligible for Tier II Alternative Energy Credits but not eligible for Solar Renewable Energy Credits.

Pursuant to Rule 1701 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, Pa.R.A.P. Rule 1701, the Commission must act to grant a petition for reconsideration within thirty days of the date of entry of the order for which reconsideration is sought, or otherwise lose jurisdiction to do so if a petition for review is timely filed. The thirty-day period within which the Commission must act upon this Petition for Reconsideration in order to preserve jurisdiction ends May 6, 2024. Accordingly, we shall grant

reconsideration, within the meaning of Pa.R.A.P. Rule 1701(b)(3), pending review of, and consideration on, the merits of the Petition; **THEREFORE**,

IT IS ORDERED: That the Petition for Reconsideration filed on April 19, 2024, by Williams Companies, Inc., is hereby granted, pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits.
