Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On March 28, 2024, PECO Energy Company ("PECO or the Company") filed Original Tariff Gas- Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 ("Tariff No. 6") containing proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations for gas distribution service. The proposed rates are designed to produce an increase in the Company's annual distribution revenue of approximately \$111 million based on a fully projected future test year ending December 31, 2025. Tariff No. 6 bears a proposed effective date of May 27, 2024.

On April 25, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") Issued an Order at Docket No. R-2024-3046932 initiating an investigation of the rates, rules and regulations set forth in Tariff No. 6 and, thereby, suspending Tariff No. 6 by operation of law until December 28, 2024, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission. The Commission's Order also directed the Company to file a suspension supplement in the form provided as an attachment to that Order.

Therefore, in compliance with the Commission's April 25, 2024 Order, PECO submits for filing with the Commission the enclosed Supplement No. 1 to Tariff Gas No.6 to reflect the suspension of Tariff No. 6 until December 28, 2024.


