MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing in this matter is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, May 8, 2024 at 10:00 a.m.
2. PECO is requesting a one (1) week continuance of the May 8, 2024, hearing date because Respondent's witness, senior claims case manager Timothy Grow, who will testify to the Complainant's case, is unavailable April 29, 2024 to May 13, 2024, due to pre-planned travel out of state. Mr. Grow will be available as of May 14, 2024.
3. PECO therefore respectfully requests a continuance from the Hearing date.
4. This is the respondent's first Continuance request in this matter.
5. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted where "good cause" exists.
6. PECO avers that "good cause" exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because PECO's witness has been the only claims case manager involved in the Complainant's property damage claim. Mr. Grow conducted a site visit at the Complainant's property and has handled her claim from its initiation in October 2022.
7. PECO has informed the Complainant that a continuance will be requested.

8. The Complainant has an objection to the Continuance request.
9. PECO respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
