Your Honor:

UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas” or the “Company”) respectfully requests that the currently-scheduled June 4, 2024, evidentiary hearing in the above-referenced proceeding be rescheduled and converted into a Prehearing Conference. UGI Gas has conferred with Sarah Aed (hereinafter, “the Complainant”) regarding this request and understands that the Complainant does not oppose the request.

The Complainant communicated to the Company that she is not available for the currently scheduled date of June 4, and therefore requires a continuance. UGI Gas is amenable to this request. To facilitate the rescheduling, both UGI Gas and the Complainant are available on June 24, 25, 26, or 28. If none of the identified dates work for Your Honor, the Company will coordinate with Complainant to identify a mutually agreeable alternative date.


In addition, the instant litigation involves the Company’s Weather Normalization Adjustment (“WNA”), which is a technical ratemaking mechanism that was approved as a five-year pilot program by the Commission in an Order entered on September 15, 2022, as part of the resolution of the Company’s most recent base rate case proceeding. Depending on the scope of the instant proceeding, UGI Gas anticipates that it may need to present detailed, technical, and/or expert testimony about the design and reasonableness of the WNA at issue, as well as the basis for the data and calculations used to apply the WNA to the Complainant’s bills. By converting the presently scheduled evidentiary hearing into a Prehearing Conference, the parties will be afforded the opportunity to discuss the issues to be litigated, the litigation schedule, potential witnesses, and other procedural guideposts.


