I appreciate that you are appearing in this matter *pro se*, meaning that you represent yourself in this matter. Nevertheless, as a party to a Commission proceeding, you must comply with the laws, rules, regulations, and policies governing the conduct of a Commission hearing. As stated in paragraph 15 of the Prehearing Order served on you, "Although the hearing is being conducted telephonically for the convenience of the parties, it is still a formal hearing and will be conducted in accordance with the PUC's Rules of Practice and Procedure at 52 Pa. Code Chapters 1, 3, and 5."

This office is not authorized or permitted to provide legal advice to any party.

In light of the email message below, you are reminded that:

- under Commission regulations, PECO is not obligated to furnish the documentation/information described in your email; and
- if you wish to obtain documentation/information from PECO for use during the hearing scheduled for 4/26/2024, you must comply with Commission regulations governing the issuance of subpoenas at 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.373 and 5.421.

In addition, please recall that subpoenas are not issued automatically. I must review any subpoena application and authorize the issuance of the subpoena. Further, if a subpoena is issued, it may be either mailed to the applicant or the applicant may be instructed by telephone to pick up the subpoena at the ALJ's office.

Moreover, you should also be aware that service of a subpoena is governed by Commission regulation 52 Pa. Code § 5.421(d). That regulation describes who may serve the subpoena, the manner of service and return of the original subpoena.
