**Implementation of the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act of 2004:  
Standards for the Participation of Demand Side Management Resources –  
Technical Reference Manual 2026 Update  
Docket No. M-2023-3044491**

On May 9, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered a Tentative Order proposing several updates to climate-related assumptions in the Technical Reference Manual (TRM), an update to the building code, expanding the TRM to calculate winter peak demand savings, and other general changes. The Commission is proposing nine new residential and 16 new non-residential measures to include in the 2026 TRM. The Commission is also proposing updates to residential and non-residential measures included from the Phase IV TRM.

This notice is to inform electric distribution companies (EDCs) and interested parties that interested persons may file comments to the Tentative Order and proposed updates to the TRM on or before thirty (30) days after this notice is published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. Thereafter, interested parties have twenty (20) days to file and serve reply comments. All filings must reference Docket No. M-2023-3044491.
