**PETITION SEEKING ABANDONMENT OF THIRD-PARTY SUPPLIER LICENSE
AND CLAIM AGAINST SURETY BOND**

TO THE HONORABLE, THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Pursuant to Sections 54.41 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“PUC” or “Commission”) Regulations, Donald V. Biase (“Biase”), the Chapter 7 Trustee, on behalf of Astral Energy, LLC, Debtor (“Astral”) by its undersigned counsel, respectfully petitions the Commission as follows:

1. Astral is currently the debtor in a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Proceeding before the Untied States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey, Case Number: 23-17424 VFP. Astral filed this voluntary bankruptcy petition on August 25, 2023. See Bankruptcy Petition, attached as Exhibit A.
2. A Chapter 7 Bankruptcy involves the liquidation of the assets of the company, and no authorization to continue to operate the business pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 721 has been sought or granted.
3. At the conclusion of the bankruptcy matter, Astral will no longer be a going concern.

4. Biase was appointed as the Chapter 7 Trustee in this matter on August 26, 2023. See Notice of Chapter 7 Bankruptcy, attached as Exhibit B.
5. As the Chapter 7 Trustee, Biase is the official representative of the Bankruptcy Estate. 11 U.S.C. § 323(a).
6. Likewise, Biase is authorized to “sue and be sued” on behalf of the Bankruptcy Estate. 11 U.S.C. § 323(b).
7. Furthermore, Biase is charged with the duty to “collect and reduce to money the property of the estate for which such trustee serves, and close such estate as expeditiously as is compatible with the best interests of parties in interest” 11 U.S.C. § 704.
8. Astral operates pursuant to Commission Approval in Docket No. A-2014-2439632.
9. Astral seeks to abandon its license, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 54.41(b). That section of the code provides that:
 - (b) A licensee may not abandon service without providing 90 days prior written notice to the Commission, the licensee's customers, the affected distribution utilities and default service providers prior to the abandonment of service. The licensee shall provide individual notice to its customers with each billing, in each of the three billing cycles preceding the effective date of the abandonment.

[52 Pa. Code § 54.41.]
10. Astral has transitioned all customers from its third-party electric supply business. As such, Astral no longer has customers served in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Likewise, Astral no longer takes service from any distribution utility. As such, no customer notice is necessary with respect to Astral’s abandonment of the license.
11. Likewise, Astral has no load to transfer to alternate entities.

12. Because of the bankruptcy, Astral failed to comply with the contractual obligations it had to its suppliers, customers, and other entities. These failures resulted in non-payment and non-service to these creditors.
13. The total amount claimed by creditors as of March 5, 2024, was in excess of \$1.5 million. See District of New Jersey Claims Register, attached as Exhibit C.
14. As part of the licensure process with the Commission, Astral has provided a surety bond pursuant to 66 Pa C.S. § 2809(c)(1)(i). This bond has a set value of \$250,000.00.
15. This amount is significantly less than the \$1.5 million in creditor claims.
16. This surety bond is identified as Bond No. 3131337, initially issued on June 11, 2016.
17. This surety bond was provided to the Commission pursuant to 66 Pa C.S. § 2809(c)(1)(i).
18. Biase, as Trustee, seeks claim upon of the value of the surety bonds for inclusion in the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Estate, for the purpose of providing compensation to the creditors of the Bankruptcy Estate, pursuant to the authority granted under 11 U.S.C. § 544.
19. Similarly, Biase, as Trustee, is operating pursuant to the concept that the surety bonds are properly pursued by the bankruptcy trustee because they inure to the benefit off all creditors, and the claim to bring the surety bond into the Bankruptcy Estate allows for the equitable distribution to all creditors. See, e.g., In re Emoral, Inc., 740 F.3d 875, 879 (3rd Cir. 2014).
20. The surety bond explicitly notes:


The condition of this obligation is such ... to ensure the supply of electricity at retail in accordance with contracts, agreements or arrangement. Payment of claims shall have the following priority: (I) The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; (II) Electric Distribution Companies for the reimbursement of Gross Receipt Taxer; and (III) Private Individuals.

21. In this matter, every one of the creditors listed on the District of New Jersey Claims Register has been damaged or suffered a loss by reason of failure to supply electricity at retail in accordance with contracts, agreements or arrangement.
22. Having the Commission execute upon the surety bonds is a proper and reasonable attempt to mitigate the damage caused by Astral's behavior, and inclusion of this value into the Bankruptcy Estate is the ideal manner for a fair and equitable distribution to all creditors in the manner prescribed by the federal Bankruptcy Code.
23. Therefore, Biase seeks a determination by the Commission that Astral has breached the terms of the surety bonds and that the surety bonds should therefore be drawn upon and provided to the Bankruptcy Trustee for inclusion and distribution through the Bankruptcy Estate.
24. Once that has occurred, Astral's abandonment of the license should also be effectuated.

CONCLUSION

For the reasons set forth above, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission issue an order approving this Petition for disbursement of the surety bonds into the Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Estate for the benefit of the creditors of Astral Energy, LLC, as well as the abandonment of the license.
