- 1 a. Please provide a comprehensive explanation of how you intend to provide reasonable and efficient transportation servicing 10 Counties from 1 facility, with 2 drivers, and with 2 – 3 proposed vehicles.
- b. Please explain what you mean by “*We will accomplish this by leasing additional vehicles.*”, when talking about enough vehicles within your business. Please know that vehicles must be owned, insured, and registered under Rapid Care Transportation LLC.

**RESPONSE:**

1a. Rapid Care Transportation will hereby amends its proposed service area in its application to include only the Counties of Lebanon, Lancaster, York, Dauphin, Cumberland, and Perry. The Company has studies and believes that there is additional demand in all of the counties initially requested and believes that it can rapidly scale up its operations to undertake any required expansion. The Company will accomplish this by hiring additional drivers as demand increases while also leasing additional vehicles to match the increase in demand. However, in order to assuage the Commission’s concerns, it will expand in phases and as demand warrants.

1b. The Company plans to have leased vehicles for staff to provide a consistent standard of services and comfort for our clients. Leasing for our drivers who meet the screening process criteria is a sensible approach. It ensures consistency in the quality of service provided to our clientele.

Opting for leasing over purchasing vehicles offers flexibility and the ability to keep our fleet updated with newer models. This allows us to trade in vehicles that require less maintenance and attention, ultimately enhancing the comfort and care provided to our clients during their journeys.
