1. Reference Application, Section 1.a, Identity of Applicant – Applicant stated throughout its EGS Application that the name of the Applicant is Sussex Energy Services, LLC. The PA Department of State stated that the Applicant’s registered name is SUSSEX ENERGY SERVICES, LLC (notice the capitalization differences). Due to this inaccuracy, please provide a letter that states that the Applicant’s name in the EGS Application contains numerous typographical errors, and the correct name of the Applicant is SUSSEX ENERGY SERVICES, LLC.
2. Reference Application, Page 1, Paragraph 1 – Applicant erroneously stated that this is the Application of Chris J. Morrone III, PE d/b/a Sussex Energy Services, LLC for approval to offer, render, furnish, or supply electricity or electric generation services. However, the instant filing is actually the Application of SUSSEX ENERGY SERVICES, LLC for approval to offer, render, furnish, or supply electricity or electric generation services. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
3. Reference Application, Section 1.a, Identity of Applicant – Applicant failed to list its name correctly in this section. Applicant also failed to list its web address in this section. Additionally, the Applicant erroneously included its owner’s name in this section. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
4. Reference Application, Section 1.b, PA Address – Applicant failed to list its name correctly in this section. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
5. Reference Application, Section 1.c, Regulatory Contact – Applicant failed to list its name correctly in this section. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
6. Reference Application, Section 1.e, Customer Complaints Contact Info – Applicant failed to list its name correctly in this section. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
7. Reference Application, Section 2.a, Fictitious Name – Applicant erroneously selected that it would be using a fictitious name within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
8. Reference Application, Section 2.b, Formation Documents – Applicant failed to provide limited liability company formation documentation. Please provide the missing documentation.

9. Reference Application, Section 6.a and 6.b, Certificate of Service – Applicant submitted an unsigned Certificate of Service to show proof of service. Please provide a signed Certificate of Service.
10. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Applicant provided minimal documentation to demonstrate financial fitness. Please provide additional financial fitness documentation that may include two recent consecutive years of financial statements, two recent consecutive years of income tax filings, and three recent consecutive months of bank statements.
11. Reference Application, Section 11, Affidavits – The affidavits submitted are from the Commission’s Natural Gas Supplier license application. Additionally, the Applicant failed to list its name correctly in this section. Commission approved affidavit templates are found in the EGS Application. Please submit the Application Affidavit and the Operations Affidavit with the appropriate corrections.
