The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PECO Energy Company's proposed Supplement No. 50 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 and the supporting rate computations submitted on May 15, 2024 to become effective on June 1, 2024.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Non-Bypassable Transmission Service Charge (NBT) rates for the six-month period of June 1, 2024 through November 30, 2024 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The NBT is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
