Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On March 28, 2024, PECO Energy Company (“PECO” or “the Company”) filed Original Tariff Gas-Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 (“Tariff No. 6”) containing proposed changes in rates, rules and regulations for gas distribution service. Tariff No. 6 bears a proposed effective date of May 27, 2024.

On April 25, 2024, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) issued an Order at Docket No. R-2024-3046932 initiating an investigation of the rates, rules and regulations set forth in Tariff No. 6 and, thereby, suspending Tariff No. 6 by operation of law until December 28, 2024, unless otherwise directed by Order of the Commission. The Commission's Order also directed the Company to file a suspension supplement in the form provided as an attachment to that Order. In compliance with the Commission's April 25, 2024 Order, PECO filed Supplement No. 1 to Tariff Gas-Pa. No. 6 to reflect the suspension of Tariff No. 6 until December 28, 2024.

Subsequently, Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl and Administrative Law Judge Darlene Heep entered a Prehearing Order in which they directed the Company to file a tariff suspending the effective date of Tariff No. 6 until December 30, 2024. Consistent with the Prehearing Order, PECO submits for filing Supplement No. 2 to Tariff Gas-Pa. P.U.C. No. 6.

**Supplement No. 2 to
ELECTRIC PA P.U.C NO. 6**

The application of rates proposed in Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 filed to become effective May 27, 2024, and suspended until December 28, 2024, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Order entered on April 25, 2024 at Docket No. R-2024-3046932, is further voluntarily suspended until December 30, 2024, subject to the condition, agreed to, or not opposed by, all parties and approved in the Prehearing Order issued on May 21, 2024 at such docket, that, if approved by the Commission, PECO Energy Company will recoup through a surcharge (the "Recoupment Surcharge") revenues lost at the final approved rates and riders for the period from January 1, 2025 through the date the Commission makes PECO Energy Company's approved rates and riders effective by approving the requisite compliance filing. The Recoupment Surcharge shall be designed to recover all such lost revenues by May 30, 2025; provided, however, that the Recoupment Surcharge shall not take effect if PECO's compliance filing is approved on or before January 1, 2025. Presently effective rates and riders set forth in Tariff Gas-Pa. P.U.C. No. 5 and supplements thereto will continue in effect until amended in the manner set forth above.

Issued in compliance with 66 Pa.C.S. § 1308(d), the Order of
the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered April 25, 2024
at Docket No. R-2024-3046932, and the Prehearing Order issued
May 21, 2024 at Docket No. R-2024-3046932 approving and memorializing
the agreement of the parties as to the conditional voluntary suspension.
