Reply to Exceptions to Initial Decision

AND NOW comes Respondent, UGI Utilities, Inc., (UGI), and replies to Exceptions filed by Complainant in the above proceeding. Complainant has filed exceptions to the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero dated May 9, 2024, dismissing the Formal Complaint by reason of Ms. Vinson's failure to satisfy her burden to demonstrate that UGI has violated the Public Utility Code, a Commission order or regulation or a Commission approved tariff.


Complainant raises no new issues in her Exceptions to the Initial Decision. Complainant merely states that her failure to obtain access to a telephone on the scheduled and noticed date of the hearing is somehow a belated after the fact justification for the scheduling of another hearing on her Complaint. UGI was prepared and ready to go forward with the hearing on the scheduled date. Complainant's exceptions should not be a basis for the scheduling of another hearing on this Complaint.

Wherefore, UGI respectfully requests that Complainant's Exceptions be denied and that the Commission adopt without modification the Initial Decision of Administrative Law Judge Eranda Vero.
