OPERATING AUTHORITY

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in group and party service, in vehicles seating eleven (11) to fifteen (15) passengers, including driver, from points in the counties of Beaver, Butler, Westmoreland, Lawrence, Armstrong, Indiana, Washington and Fayette, to points in Pennsylvania, and return, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ITEM 1- **ADVANCE RESERVATIONS**
Reservations must be made six (6) hours prior to service being provided.
- ITEM 2- **HOURLY RATES**
Hourly rates are calculated from the time the vehicle leaves the carrier's garage until the vehicle returns to the carrier's garage.
- ITEM 3- **PAYMENT OF OUT-OF-POCKET EXPENSES**
All tolls, parking fees and any other out-of-pocket expenses shall be the responsibility of the customer and will be added on the carrier's charges.
- ITEM 4- **DRIVER GRATUITY**
An eighteen (18) percent driver gratuity will be assessed in addition to all other published rates and charges.

SCHEDULE OF RATES

PASSENGERS SHALL BE ADVISED OF FARE PRIOR TO TRIP

ITEM 1 – RATES:

- a. Rates are calculated on the basis of the distance and time between the point of origination and the destination, and include a minimum base fare.
- b. Flat fees may be charged for trips to specific destinations.
- c. Rates may increase or decrease in real time for the purpose of balancing supply and demand. At times of tight supply, such as special events or holiday, dynamic pricing may go into effect.
- d. When a natural disaster or emergency results in a state of disaster emergency being declared by the Governor of Pennsylvania, dynamic pricing will be computed to comply with the Pennsylvania Price Gouging Act, 73, P.S. §§ 232.1, *et seq.* For any natural disaster or emergency that does not result in a state of disaster emergency being declared by the Governor of Pennsylvania, the dynamic pricing will be established on the basis of prices charged over the preceding sixty days.
- e. Tolls, Airport Transfer fees and similar use and access charges may be passed directly on to the customer and do not require addendum or changes to this Tariff for an increase or decrease in those charges.

ITEM 2 – DISCOUNT AND COUPONS:

- a. Rates may be discounted for special groups, programs, contracts and repeat customers.
- b. Rate may be discounted through the purchase or use of coupons.

ITEM 3: In all situations, the prospective customers will be advised of the applicable rates being charged and will have the option of receiving an estimated fare before booking the ride.

ITEM 4: Cancellation and cleaning fees may be applied as necessary, with advance notice.
