SPECIAL APPEARANCE MOTION TO STRIKE WITH JUDICIAL NOTICE

This SPECIAL APPEARANCE Motion to Strike with Judicial Notice of June 6, 2024, in response to the June 5, 2024 PECO motion to dismiss with the same routine content as the prior motion to dismiss, presents the threshold matter: either the PUC will continue in that socio-path or “repent” with readily-available logic and reasoning (can public officials stop being puppets of a “new world order – build back better” bullyism so all the “despicables” don’t have to eat ze bugs when they can’t afford electricity anymore or else don’t have to suffer loss of electricity for life needs because they used up their low score social credit quota? 1. **§ 5.103. Motions.** (d) *Rulings on motions.* (1) The presiding officer is authorized to rule and will rule upon motions: (i) Not formerly acted upon by the Commission prior to the commencement of the hearing where an immediate ruling is essential in order to proceed with the hearing.

2. **§ 5.101. Preliminary objections.**

(a) *Grounds.* Preliminary objections are available to parties and may be filed in response to a pleading **except motions and prior preliminary objections.**

This special appearance Motion to Strike with Judicial Notice preserves the record that special appearance Complainant has objected to the prejudicial subversion of the Rule of Law including but not limited to ignoring special appearance Complainant’s motions up to the present, while ruling **prematurely, out of order and against the rules** on PECO’s first desperate hope for dismissal because special appearance Complainant never presents facts regarding a health issue
