

**FOURTH STATUS REPORT OF AQUA PENNSYLVANIA, INC., THE  
PENNSYLVANIA OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE, THE OFFICE OF SMALL  
BUSINESS ADVOCATE, AND THE COALITION FOR AFFORDABLE UTILITY  
SERVICES AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN PENNSYLVANIA**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Aqua” or the “Company”) submits the following Status Report, pursuant to Prehearing Order #1 dated February 8, 2024, entered in this matter by the Presiding Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding (“ALJ”). Aqua has been authorized to present this Fourth Status Report on its behalf as well as on behalf of the Pennsylvania Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”), the Pennsylvania Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”), and the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (“CAUSE-PA”) (“collectively the “Parties”).

**I. Introduction**

On February 8, 2024, the ALJ in this matter, the Honorable Charece Z. Collins, issued a Prehearing Order that stated that the Parties have until Friday May 10, 2024 to discuss a potential settlement in this matter, and that the Parties shall e-mail a monthly status report to the ALJ no later than March 11, 2024, April 10, 2024, and May 10, 2024 (“Prehearing Order”). Aqua submitted the first status, second, and third status reports on behalf of the Parties on March 11, April 10, and May 10, 2024, respectively. In the May 10, 2024, status report, the Parties requested an additional thirty days to facilitate ongoing settlement discussions, which the ALJ granted.


## **II. Status Report**

The Parties in this proceeding are continuing to discuss the potential settlement of this matter and continue to believe that this matter can be resolved without the need for litigation. As such, the Parties respectfully request that the settlement period in this proceeding be extended an additional thirty days, until Wednesday, July 10, 2024, to allow the Parties time to develop a term sheet.
