Please accept this letter as Environ Energy LLC's petition for reconsideration pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Sec. 5.572(c). regarding Final Order M-2024-3045253, which was entered on May 20, 2024.

We would kindly ask the Commission to accept this \$350 payment in response to the dunning letter 23-1217603-AD regarding Environ Energy LLC's unpaid 2023-2024 NGS licensing fee. Due to factors related to complex multiple transitions that were occurring within our company when Annual Fee invoices were issued last year, both the invoice and this follow-up letter were overlooked, for which we sincerely apologize. This was an unintentional oversight; Environ Energy did pay its Electric Annual Fee last year and is compliant with all reporting and bonding requirements for both its Electric and Natural Gas licensing. Unfortunately, this fee was not tendered to, and again, we are sorry it was not taken care of according to PUC regulations or in a timely manner.

We have paid our 2024-2025 NGS Annual Fee (Invoice #24-1217603-A), which should reach the Fiscal Office separately from this petition by 5/28/2024. We have also adjusted our processes internally so this oversight does not happen again in the future.

Thank you very much for your consideration in this matter; we are hopeful that our NGS license might be reinstated after the Commission's review of this petition without a need to file a new application.

The Commission may additionally suspend or revoke your company's license.
