INTERIM ORDER
ACCEPTING PETITION TO WITHDRAW AND CLOSING THE RECORD

On November 27, 2020, Keisha Truax (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against West Penn Power Company (West Penn Power) alleging that the smart meter installed at her service address needs to be removed, citing a number of health conditions, including EMF sensitivity, which are exacerbated by Wi-Fi and cellular radiation

On May 9, 2024, I received an email from Complainant stating that she no longer lives in Pennsylvania. On May 21, 2024, I issued a Rule to Show Cause stating that I would construe the Complainant’s email as a request to withdraw her complaint unless I received objections on or before June 3, 2024. No objections have been filed.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the May 9, 2024, email from Keisha Truax attached to this order shall be considered a petition to withdraw the Formal Complaint of Keisha Truax filed on November 27, 2020.

2. That the record in Docket No. C-2020-3023039 is closed.

3. That an Initial Decision shall be prepared and issued.
