**BRIEFING ORDER**

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That main briefs in the above-captioned matters are due on or before June 21, 2024, and reply briefs are due on or before July 9, 2024.
  
2. That the parties must comply with 52 Pa. Code §§5.501, et seq., regarding the preparation and filing of briefs. Service can be made electronically by no later than 4:30 p.m. on the dates listed. Parties are directed to e-mail us searchable copies of their as-filed briefs in ADOBE or other compatible PDF format in addition to a WORD-formatted document. The format of the briefs served electronically on the parties may be as requested by the parties.
  
3. That, in addition to the mandatory contents set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.501(a), all main briefs, regardless of length, must contain:
  - A. A table of contents;
  - B. A history of the proceeding;
  - C. A discussion;
  - D. Proposed findings of facts (with record citations to transcript pages or exhibits where supporting evidence appears);

- E. Proposed conclusions of law (with citations to supporting statutes, regulations, or relevant case law); and
- F. Proposed ordering paragraphs specifically identifying the relief sought.

52 Pa. Code § 5.501(e) requires that “Briefs shall be as concise as possible.”

4. That the page limitations for briefs are 60 pages for main briefs and 40 pages for reply briefs.

5. That if a party does not file a reply brief, it will be assumed that the party does not dispute the assertions, contentions or arguments made by the other parties in their main briefs. **While it is not necessary in a reply brief to repeat a particular argument or discussion contained in the main brief, the reply brief should note where the responsive argument is located in the main brief and how it responds to the other parties’ assertions, contentions, or arguments.**

6. That any brief not filed and served on or before the date fixed therefore will not be accepted for filing, except by permission for good cause.

7. That briefs must include proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and proposed ordering paragraphs. Proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs may be placed in an appendix to the brief and, therefore, do not count toward the aforementioned page limits.

8. If any party fails to follow these instructions in the smallest detail that party’s position will not be considered, regardless of where the record may support it or the position of any other party to this proceeding.

9. Any of the provisions of this Order may be modified upon motion and good cause shown by any party in interest.

10. That any settlement documents, whether settling this proceeding in whole or in part, are due on or before Friday, July 5, 2024, with Statements in Support or Non-Opposition from all signatories.
