I have been transporting goods interstate for approx 40 years.  
I began my career employed by my father, Mr. Arthur Watson Sr.  
We delivered for Metropolitan Fine Furniture and also Spring Air Mattress Co.  
I was also employed by Robert M. Sides Family Music Center's delivering  
instruments and pianos for nearly 20 years before branching off into my Company*

- 2.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant.

- a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks. Please review Title 52 Pa Code §31.134 – Criminal History to see what is required of motor carriers.

- i. How often will the criminal background checks be conducted?  
ii. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed?

- i Criminal background checks upon entry and every 2 years thereafter.  
ii I will maintain these records in a locked cabinet in my office*

- b. Your system for conducting driver license/history checks. Please review Title 52 Pa Code §37.204, 49 CFR §391.25 to see what is required of motor carriers.

- i. How often will driver license/history checks be conducted.  
ii. How will you maintain records of driver license/history checks?

*Drivers licensing checks will be conducted upon entry of position  
and annually thereafter*


- 3.) Question #7 of the application asks you to describe your vehicle safety program. Do you conduct any pre/post trip inspections on the vehicles, and what does that entail?
