The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's quarterly Smart Meter Charge (SMC) filing submitted on June 21, 2024 to become effective on July 1, 2024. In this filing, the company is not proposing to revise its currently effective rate of zero.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Smart Meter Charge (SMC) charge for the three-month period of July 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The SMC charge is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
