ORDER
COMPLAINANT’S SECOND REQUEST FOR A CONTINUANCE GRANTED

This matter was set for hearing on May 29, 2024. The Complainant, with no objection from Respondent, requested a continuance. On May 16, 2024, the attorney for the Respondent, Maragret A. Morris, Esquire, advised the undersigned of the Complainant’s request and the hearing scheduled for May 29, 2024 was continued to July 2, 2024.

The Complainant has requested another continuance, contending that there are outstanding discovery issues and that he has a family vacation scheduled. What information the Complainant is seeking from Aqua is not clear in the email and pleadings.

Additionally, Aqua asserts that a call with the Complainant was scheduled on May 31, 2024,” but cancelled that morning. . . He has not rescheduled. He scheduled a meter test and did not show; the meter was tested in his presence 2 days later,” and referenced a finding in *Mazza v PECO*, Docket No. C-2012-2318472, Opinion and Order entered April 23, 2014. Aqua also asserts that the Complainant has not specified what charges he is disputing.

Mr. Mazza’s request for continuance will be granted; however, to avoid further delay, no further continuances will be granted to the Complainant in this matter. Further, Mr. Mazza will be required by 5 p.m. today to clarify for Aqua what he is seeking in informal

discovery. This clarification can be provided by email, with a copy to the undersigned. He should also specify the charges at issue.

THEREFORE

IT IS ORDERED

1. That Complainant's Motion for Continuance of the July 2, 2024 hearing is granted.
2. That the hearing will be held telephonically on July 9, 2024 beginning at 1:30 p.m.
3. That no additional requests of the Complainant for continuances will be granted.
4. That by 5 p. m. today, Mr. Mazza must provide Aqua with clarification of the discovery he is seeking and specify which charges he is contesting, with a copy to the undersigned.
5. That no later than noon on July 8, 2024, the parties should exchange any exhibits that they intend to present at the July 9, 2024 hearing
