Dear Secretary's Bureau:

This firm represents Cetronia Ambulance Corps, Incorporated t/d/b/a Cetronia Ambulance Corps, which is applying for amended paratransit authority at Docket No. A-2024-3048889. It is our understanding (based on an email from Kevin Morgan in the Bureau of Technical Utility Services he sent to me on Monday, July 8, 2024) that the amended authority at Docket No. A-2024-3048889 can only be issued if Cetronia Ambulance Corps discontinues its Certificate of Public Convenience issued at Docket No. A-00120701. For this reason alone and contingent upon the Commission's issuance of the Certificate of Public Convenience at Docket No. A-2024-3048889 in such a manner that Cetronia Ambulance Corps does not have a lapse in or absence of paratransit authority, files the attached "Application for Approval of Abandonment or Discontinuance of Service, In Whole Or In Part," for Cetronia Ambulance Corps, Incorporated t/d/b/a Cetronia Ambulance Corps's authority at Docket No. A-00120701, which is what we understand needs to be filed in order for the PUC to issue Cetronia Ambulance Corps a Certificate of Convenience for its expanded authority. To be clear, this filing is only for a discontinuance in part, and is only for a discontinuance of the paratransit authority the PUC originally issued to Cetronia Ambulance Corps back in 2005!


