Complainant agrees but will argue previous resolution settlement (BCS No: 3819481) dated March 7, 2022 by PUC Investigator Bryan Kauffman was not followed by FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company. It was FirstEnergy billing department that changed the settlement and FirstEnergy's billing department that had no answers for the changes and suggested the informal complaint process to further investigate. Again.

13. The Commission's policy is to promote settlement. 52 Pa. Code § 5.231.

Complainant agrees but must stipulate FirstEnergy's reluctance to follow said resolution(s) and has yet to offer any in this current matter. In fact Complainant disagrees with many of the answers in sections 4, 5, 7a above.
