Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Our firm serves as counsel to the Borough of Hanover and represents Hanover Municipal Water Works (“Borough”) in the above-referenced matter. By electronic filing, please accept this letter as the Borough’s general petition pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.41 for a **one hundred fifty (150)** day Extension of Time (“Extension”) to file its Petition for Approval of its Lead Service Line Replacement Program (“LSLR Petition”), as required by the Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations located at 52 Pa. Code § 65.1, *et seq.*

The original due date for the Borough to file its LSLR Petition is July 22, 2024. Through this Extension, the Borough is requesting that the deadline be extended to December 19, 2024. The Borough is in the process of refining its dataset to fully inform the existence of lead piping relevant to preparation of its LSLR Petition, if any. It is currently employing a web-based GIS tool for water customers and is engaged in a public messaging campaign to improve rates of responses. This is in addition to the Borough’s exhaustive review of its records, including permitting, testimony, and field investigations. The results of these efforts will help inform the ultimate structure of its LSLR Plan to be carried out over the next 30 years in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 65.53(b), which will be submitted for Commission approval.
