Enclosed please find reports on the Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania's 2023 Meter Sampling program for Class A, B and C meters.

The Class A meters followed the same statistical sampling plan as in previous years and completed the required number of meter removals and tests.

The 2023 Class B and Class C variable interval program did not complete the required amount of removals. All meters in the Class B and C Miscellaneous families are retired from service once they are removed.
