**Re: Affiliated Service Agreement between Duquesne Light Company and Its Affiliate

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §2101 et. seq., Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or “Company”) hereby files for approval the enclosed confidential Affiliate Services Agreement (“ASA”) between The Efficient Network (“TEN”) and the Company. The subject agreement concerns the provision of a level II energy audit for Duquesne Light facilities. Duquesne is seeking to improve the energy efficiency of Company facilities, and a level II energy audit is the next step in that process. In seeking assistance with the energy audit, three service providers engaged with the Company to provide services. Of those three, only TEN submitted a formal bid.

Duquesne Light Company and TEN are both wholly owned subsidiaries of Duquesne Light Holdings. As a result of this relationship, the Agreement is subject to the Affiliated Interest Agreement provisions of the Public Utility Code. The enclosed Agreement is marked as CONFIDENTIAL ATTACHMENT A. Duquesne Light respectfully request that Attachments A be treated as confidential and protected from public disclosure as it contains competitive information. The CONFIDENTIAL Version of this filing will be uploaded to the Commission’s SharePoint site.

A breakdown of the facilities to be audited by TEN, along with the expected hours and costs, is provided in the Agreement. The scope and cost of the bid was in the expected range for the services requested. Approval of the Agreement is in the public interest as TEN is highly qualified with direct experience completing similar projects for other entities. Duquesne is interested in moving forward with the energy audit, and expected efficiency recommendations upon completion of the audit, in order to reduce operating costs to the benefit of both the Company



and ratepayers. The Company requests that the Commission approve the Agreement as soon as is reasonably practicable. Duquesne is available to promptly answer any questions on this matter.


