The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is in receipt of your letter dated July 26, 2024, that requests to have the due date for providing responses to TUS Data Request Set 2 for the above-referenced Application extended until August 30, 2024. York Water-WW indicated that it needs more time to gather the requested information and materials. Please be advised your request is hereby granted and responses to TUS Data Request Set 2 are now due by August 30, 2024.

York Water-WW is advised that the Commission may not grant additional requests to extend the due date for responses to TUS Data Request Set 2 beyond August 30, 2024. If York Water-WW cannot provide the requested information by August 30, 2024, York Water-WW should consider filing a letter to this docket requesting to withdraw the Application and to refile the Application when York Water-WW can provide the required information. Also, failure to provide responses to TUS Data Request Set 2 or to request to withdraw the Application may result in rejection of the Application. 52 Pa. Code § 3.501(a).

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
