**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY  
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company, on behalf of its Met-Ed Rate District, (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Darsh Singh, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for August 1, 2024. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

**I. BACKGROUND**

1. On or about February 1, 2024, Lirieth Herrera Clark (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 1305 Garmisch Court, East Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania 18301 (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100141117950 (“Account”).

2. On February 21, 2024, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On June 10, 2024, an Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing Notice was issued in this proceeding scheduling a hearing for August 1, 2024.

4. The Company’s witness is unavailable during the scheduled hearing date and time due to bereavement leave.

5. On July 26, 2024 and July 29, 2024 the undersigned counsel reached out to Administrative Law Judge Arlene Ashton via her legal assistant to advise of the witness' unavailability. On July 30, 2024, the Company contacted Complainant to see if she would be agreeable to a continuance of the hearing in this matter but was unable to reach her.

6. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for August 1, 2024, in this matter be continued to a later date, when both parties are available to participate.

7. The parties are available for hearing on the following dates: August 19, 20, 23, 26, 27, 29 and 30, 2024

## **II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**


8. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).


