Re: Electric Generation Supplier License of Veolia Sustainable Buildings USA East, Inc.

Dear Ms. Fawcett:

On April 24, 2024, SourceOne, Inc. (DE) d/b/a SourceOne Energy, Inc. (SourceOne) filed a request with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) to change the name on its license to provide electric generation services, as a broker/marketer, to Veolia Sustainable Buildings USA East, Inc. (Veolia Sustainable Buildings).

Currently, SourceOne is licensed as SourceOne, Inc. (DE) d/b/a SourceOne Energy, Inc. as a broker/marketer to large commercial (over 25 kW demand), industrial, and governmental customers in all of the electric distribution company service territories throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Veolia Sustainable Buildings has provided the proper Pennsylvania Department of State documentation and has provided proof of service to the interested parties as required by the Commission. Furthermore, Veolia Sustainable Buildings has provided an update to its financial security instrument reflecting its new name.

Therefore, the Commission approves, by this Secretarial Letter, the change of SourceOne, Inc. (DE) d/b/a SourceOne Energy, Inc.'s name on its license for the provision of electric generation services as a broker/marketer.

The Secretary's Bureau will issue a new license to Veolia Sustainable Buildings USA East, Inc. the right to begin to offer, render, furnish, or supply electric generation services as a broker/marketer to large commercial (over 25 kW demand), industrial, and governmental customers in all of the electric distribution company service territories throughout the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The Secretary's Bureau and the Bureau of Administration, Financial and Assessments will update the company's name in their computer systems and lists, as appropriate, to be Veolia Sustainable Buildings USA East, Inc.
