Application of CSX Transportation, Inc. for approval of the abolition of two (2) crossings where Strickler Street (DOT 145 461 L) and Griscom Street (DOT 145 455 H) cross, at grade, two (2) tracks of CSX Transportation, Inc. located in Dawson Borough, Fayette County.

To Whom It May Concern:

On July 9, 2024, CSX Transportation Inc., submitted final construction plans to abolish two (2) crossings where Strickler Street (DOT 145 461 L) and Griscom Street (DOT 145 455 H) cross, at grade, two (2) tracks of CSX Transportation, Inc. located in Dawson Borough, Fayette County. On July 15, 2024, CSX Transportation, Inc., submitted an amended plan for the abolition of the at-grade crossing on Griscom Street. The plans are in accordance with Numbered Paragraphs 4 through 9 of the Commission's Secretarial Letter dated, June 15, 2023, in the above-captioned proceeding.

The final construction plan for the abolition of the at-grade crossing on Strickler Street is entitled "DAWSON BOROUGH, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CLOSURE OF STRICKLER STREET GRADE CROSSING WITH CSXT CENTRAL ZONE, PITTSBURGH SUBDIVISION DOT 145461L, MP BF-275.94," consisting of one (1) sheet, submitted on July 9, 2024.

The final construction plan for the abolition of the at-grade crossing on Griscom Street is entitled "DAWSON BOROUGH, FAYETTE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CLOSURE OF GRISCOM STREET GRADE CROSSING WITH CSXT CENTRAL ZONE, PITTSBURGH SUBDIVISION DOT 145455H, MP BF-275.74," consisting of one (1) sheet, submitted on July 15, 2024.

CSX Transportation Inc., avers that each party to the proceeding was sent a copy of the final construction plans for review. CSX Transportation Inc., E-filed the plans with the Commission. None of the parties have advised this Commission that it objects to approval of the plans.

Please be advised that the plans have been certified as the correct plans and are hereby approved.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission's website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
