1. **Annual Inquiry and Review of Driving Record (49 CFR 391.25):**

- At least once every 12 months, TomKat Movers will make an inquiry to obtain the motor vehicle record of each driver you employ. Obtain records from each driver's licensing authority where they held a commercial motor vehicle operator's license or permit during the preceding 12 months
- Review each driver's motor vehicle record to determine whether they meet minimum requirements for safe driving or are disqualified to drive a commercial motor vehicle. Consider evidence of violations of Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations and other relevant laws (e.g., speeding, reckless driving, operating under the influence) when assessing safety

2. **Driver History:**

- Maintain a record of each driver's history, including violations, accidents, and any disqualifications.
- Regularly update this history based on annual inquiries and reviews.

3. **Schedule:**

- Create a clear schedule for our drivers, including routes, delivery times, and rest breaks.
- Ensure compliance with hours-of-service regulations (49 CFR Part 395) to prevent driver fatigue.

4. **Retention:**

- Retain copies of motor vehicle records obtained annually (from step 1) in each driver's qualification file.
- Document the review of driving records (from step 1) with a note, including the reviewer's name and date of review, in the driver's qualification file

1. **Criminal History**

- Following receipt of the initial criminal history record, a household goods carrier shall obtain and review a criminal history record for each employee providing moving services from the Pennsylvania State Police every 2 years from the date of the last criminal history check.
- Disqualification: A household goods carrier may not permit a person to provide moving services in a shipper's dwelling when the person was convicted of a

felony or a misdemeanor under the laws of the Commonwealth or under the laws of another jurisdiction, to the extent the conviction relates adversely to that person's suitability to provide service safely and legally.

- Record Retention: A copy of the criminal history shall be maintained by the household goods carrier for at least 3 years.

- Create a clear schedule for your drivers, including routes, delivery times, and rest breaks.

# TomKat Vehicle Inspection Checklist

## 1. Exterior Inspection:

- Check for any visible damage, dents, or scratches on the vehicle's body
- Inspect mirrors, lights (headlights, taillights, turn signals), and windshield for cracks or defects
- Ensure tires are properly inflated and have sufficient tread depth
- Do 360-degree video of vehicle, send to dispatch

## 2. Fluid Checks (inside hood):

- Engine oil: Verify oil level and condition. Oil must be halfway minimum
- Transmission fluid: Check fluid level (if applicable)
- Brake fluid: Ensure it's at the recommended level
- Coolant/antifreeze: Confirm proper levels
- Power steering fluid: Check for leaks or low levels
- Windshield washer fluid: Ensure it's filled

## 3. Interior Inspection:

- Seatbelts: Confirm they're functional and secure
- Dashboard lights: Check for warning lights (e.g., check engine, tire pressure)
- HVAC system: Test heating, defrosters, and air conditioning

## 4. Safety and Maintenance Equipment:

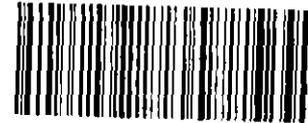
