Re: Letter of Notification of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation to Reconstruct sections of the Juniata – Cumberland 230 kV Transmission Line and Williams Grove 230 kV Transmission Line in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania.

Dear Mr. Lent:

On July 16, 2024, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) filed a Letter of Notification for approval to reconstruct sections of the Juniata – Cumberland 230 kV Transmission Line and Williams Grove – Cumberland 230 kV Transmission Line in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. In order for us to complete our analysis of the subject application, the Bureau of Technical Utility Services requires answers to the enclosed data requests. This information is necessary for completion of our review of the filing.

Please forward the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within ten (10) days** of receipt of this letter. Failure to respond may result in the Letter of Notification being denied. As well, if PPL Electric has decided to withdraw its filing, please reply notifying the Commission of such a decision.

The Commission is accepting all public documents through our efilings system at this time.

- A-1 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 11. Please explain why the NERC standard violation is now an issue where it wasn't previously.
- A-2 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 18. Please explain whether the subject project is a baseline or supplemental project and provide a detailed explanation as to why. Additionally, please provide the associated PJM project number.
- A-3 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 28. Please quantify the anticipated increase in reliability in terms of customer average interruption duration index, system average interruption duration index, and system average interruption frequency index.
- A-4 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 28. Please explain whether the proposed project meets NERC or PJM minimum planning criteria or whether it exceeds these criteria to meet transmission owner planning criteria. If the project exceeds either of these minimum planning criteria to meet transmission owner criteria, provide a detailed explanation as to why.
- A-5 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 1, page 2. Please state the approximate age and service life of the existing transmission assets to be replaced. Additionally, please describe the health of these assets.
- A-6 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 2, page 2. Please state the approximate width of the existing right-of-way.
- A-7 Reference the Letter of Notification. Please explain whether the subject project reconstructs a section of the Juniata – Cumberland 230 kV Transmission Line which was previously reconfigured and the subject of Docket No. A-2022-3036291.
